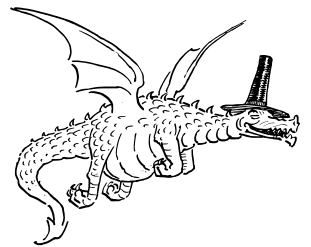


Scavenger Hunt - Complete our scavenger hunt and take home a book to keep.
